

Advocacy Efforts Help to Complete Harborwalk

Seaport TMA is pleased to announce our latest accomplishment in successfully advocating for the completion of the Boston Harborwalk along Dorchester Avenue and the Fort Point Channel.

This segment of the Harborwalk is a critical link between Summer Street/South Station, and the Fort Point Channel neighborhood as it provides an inviting, enjoyable and safe pedestrian walkway and viewing area for commuters, residents and visitors.



Over the last seven months, Seaport TMA remained the lead advocate and primary liaison between the Massachusetts Highway Department (MHD), the Boston Redevelopment Authority (BRA), general contractors and area abutters. **Our advocacy efforts over this timeframe included:**

- Pushing for regular updates from MHD and the contractor to ensure construction schedule was adhered to as much as possible;
- Demanding improved safety in and around the construction site;
- Ensuring an unsecured boat ramp leading into the Fort Point Channel from the sidewalk was removed;
- Remaining persistent that the Harborwalk plantings be installed this season;
- Firmly supporting overall completion of the project before the winter months.
